We lead the revolution in the intuitive sciences and sacred leadership by providing access to world-class, socially responsible, ethically informed and evidence based training programs, as taught by highly trained, congruent and experienced mentors and teachers, committed to their own ongoing professional, personal and spiritual development.

The Institute is committed to creating a gold-standard benchmark in the field of the intuitive sciences and new paradigm priestess training, because in an unregulated industry, the standards we set are our own.

Excellence, ethical service, the pursuit of spiritual innovation and ongoing research inform all of the activities of the Institute for this is how we believe we can take the new conversation on intuition to the world.

We are committed to the core values and ethically informed policies as outlined below:

- Women-centred
 - Our focus is and always will be on contributing to the ongoing rise of women (trans and cis) and the second great mystical renaissance that human consciousness is now experiencing

- o We commit to training women and to develop the spiritual self-esteem of women as a core mission because the last 8,000 years of patriarchy have created an imbalance between men and women in regards to political, economic, personal and spiritual rights, and we are committed to redressing this imbalance

 - o We do not pursue our path of sacred service for personal gain alone, or for attainment of the betterment of our own lives alone. Our work is in the world, on behalf of all.
 - o We understand the privilege and freedom we have in pursuing our soul's awakening, and we will not squander that privilege
 - o It is our privilege to be of service, and we know that it has nothing to do with our personal (personality) agenda. We are God's hands and feet in the world, and we take our instructions directly from the Source, even when it is inconvenient and uncomfortable.
 - o We are not here for our comfort, but our evolution.
- Beyond the trinkets and superstitions of the new age
 - o We stand for the deep work of the deep faith that privileges the truth that we are energy first, physical second
 - o We adhere to the truth that consciousness is antecedent to matter, and that as priestesses of nonlocal consciousness, we commit to create change at the nonlocal level first, followed by action at the local level
 - o A trinket or superstition is any belief, action or object to which meaning is assigned that suggests or encourages dualism. We walk the path of nondualism, and honour the immutable hermetic laws as our guiding principles – the laws of mentalism, correspondence and vibration.
 - o We bring things back to their most logical conclusion, focus on moving our students and clients from fear to love as THE work of healing, provide evidence where possible for what we do and why we do it, innovate and evolve where required, and accept no quick fixes or magic bullets on this awakening

 - Socio-economic disadvantage. We offer multiple scholarships to women who self-assess as being in need of financial support to access the Third Level program
 - Disability Action Plan. We are currently developing a plan to ensure access to our programs for women (trans and cis) of different abilities, and we are committed to creating safe spaces online and offline for differently-abled women who desire to access our programs
 - Body Equality. The Institute is committed to creating safe spaces online and offline for all bodies, and to continue to educate ourselves in this rapidly evolving area of consciousness raising. We quote Jes Baker; "Making peace with our bodies and learning to love them is also about radical social justice and change. It includes a deep look at racism, violence, biased health care, fatphobia, inaccessible spaces, discrimination, limited resources, gendered bathrooms, sexism, irrelevant age limitations, and so much more. I'd love to see Body Positivity fully encompass Body Equality, but as of right now we haven't be able to merge them in the mainstream. Yet."

 - We are committed to honouring our teaching lineage, and identifying our sources. We will not accommodate or collude in plagiarism, misrepresentation or de-identification of those

who have informed and inspired our work. If we unintentionally do so we will correct the error.

- o We commit to collaborate to the best of our ability with only those who share congruent ethics and values
 - o We commit to use language responsibly and to never make ambit claims or evidence-less statements. We will not use language that causes harm, and if we are shown to be doing so we will listen, learn and correct the error. We will not over claim or deceive others in regards to the any aspect of our work.
- Congruence
 - o The Institute's work in the world, its teachers, mentors and leaders are committed wholeheartedly to be the demonstration of our deep faith and values
 - o This includes proudly using the word God in our teachings.
 - Ongoing personal, spiritual and professional development
 - o These three pillars that underpin all the training we provide define the Institute Code of Ethics. Both mentors and students are expected to continue to maintain a commitment to these three pillars, during and after their studies. It is for this reason the Institute has created the Alumni community and postgraduate program for all graduates of the Third Level, which provides access to all three pillars
 - Personal development includes the commitment to continued social consciousness raising, self-education, self-inquiry and the pursuit of dismantling subconscious biases and fear programs to be the clearest possible vessel on the path of service
 - Spiritual development means to privilege one's relationship to devotion above all else, and to centre the relationship with our God Self in all we do.
 - Professional development ensures the maintenance of and contribution to skills development for all those working with clients in complimentary therapies, energy medicine and life coaching.
